



BNSUD REGISTRATION UPDATE

If you are receiving this message, you have registered and created a profile at www.bnsud.ca. There are updates to the registration process that are being put in place due to the changes in Public Health guidelines and we want to meet and exceed all of those to keep everyone as safe as possible.

Here would be the remaining steps:

- 1) **Pay your registration** – If you have paid your registration, move to step 2.

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is preferred to treasurer@bnsud.ca.

Registration rates are:

Level 1 and 2 - \$70.00

Level 3 - \$100

Level 4 and 5 - \$140*

- 2) Once registration is paid, the **online learning modules** will be assigned to your user profile based on your level. The modules are listed below.

- 3) If you had completed your modules, we have added an additional module due to the change to our in-person planning – see step 7. All umpires are expected to complete all the modules assigned. You won't be added to our actual registration list until payment is received and all modules are completed.
- 4) Your online learning will be done through the new website. Most of the modules are approximately 10 to 20 minutes in length.
- 5) PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU COMPLETE YOUR MODULES. There are 5 questions quizzes after the MP4 videos for each module. Please ensure that the videos/ links are reviewed and not just the questions. We are noticing that many are just answering the questions and moving on to the next module. Please review all modules – we don't want to back track and have those who are not viewing the modules to redo them. The quizzes must be completed after watching the video to complete the module.

- 6) Once the online modules for your level are complete there will be the exam – done through the website for Level 1 and 2 – true or false answers. For Level 3, we are working with Baseball Canada to get this set up – more details to follow. For 4 and 5 the exams will be completed at umpire.baseball.ca.
- 7) As was stated earlier in this update, we will NOT be holding in person positioning/ practical umpiring clinics at this time. We are moving to interactive ZOOM sessions – dates and time below. Taking one of these sessions is mandatory for NEW umpires and strongly recommended for Level 1 and 2 umpires. We need to limit each ZOOM session to a maximum of 90 participants. The ZOOM sessions are now on the webpage under “Clinics”. We will look to add more sessions if there is a need.
